1) Infant Mental Health Services

FOM 802, Mental Health, Behavioral Health, and Developmental Needs of Foster Children

This item was updated to include information on infant mental health services, social-emotional warning signs in infants and toddlers, and the standard of promptness for referrals for infant mental health evaluations.

Reason: Michigan Department of Human Services and Michigan Association for Infant Mental Health joint policy statement.

2) Mental Health Screening

FOM 802, Mental Health, Behavioral Health, and Developmental Needs of Foster Children

The Medicaid Provider Manual was amended necessitating a change in foster care policy and practice. Medical providers may, but are no longer required, to use a normed and validated screening tool when completing a child’s initial medical exam and/or well-child exam.

Reason: Medicaid Provider Manual changes.
