Subject***JJ4 470, Detention Alternatives, Detention and Jail***

Detention and jail are the most restrictive placements available and do not provide rehabilitative treatment for juvenile offenders. The assigned case manager must ensure that alternatives to placement in detention or jail are considered and that when it is necessary to place a youth in detention or jail, the restrictions on placement in detention or jail are followed.

Reason: Policy clarification and update to accompany the new DHS-2012, Detention/Jail Placement Exception Request. See concurrent foster care payment policy release FOM 903-2, Payment for Detention Care.
