**1. NEW COMBINED
IV-D MANUAL ITEM
300**

The new Combined IV-D Manual Item 300 is a combination of several of the Office of Child Support (OCS) manual items, Friend of the Court (FOC) chapters, and Prosecuting Attorney (PA) Handbook items. It addresses terminology, concepts and procedures used in conjunction with child support interstate policy.

**2. NEW COMBINED
IV-D MANUAL ITEM
305**

The new Combined IV-D Manual Item 305 is a combination of several of the OCS manual items, FOC chapters, and PA Handbook items which address the Uniform Interstate Family Support Act. This item describes the steps and processes involved with interstate cases.

**3. NEW COMBINED
IV-D MANUAL ITEM
310**

The new Combined IV-D Manual Item 310 is a combination of several of the OCS manual items, FOC chapters, and PA Handbook items. This item relates to Interstate Redirection of Support, the appropriate use and application of the process.

**4. NEW COMBINED
IV-D MANUAL ITEM
320**

The new Combined IV-D Manual Item 320 is an overview of the policy on reciprocal agreements between nations, states and provinces in regards to the child support process. The two exhibit items, 320X1 and 320X2, list the nations and provinces with reciprocal agreements; and, provides the international reciprocity address directory.

These four manual items and the exhibits are a combination of several other manual group items: OCS Manual Items 220, CR-223; FOC chapters 240, 410, 412, 415; PA Handbook Item 260.

5. FYI: USE OF ON-LINE MANUALS AND REDUCTION OF PAPER MANUAL DISTRIBUTION.

In the near future, notice to Michigan Family Independence Agency (MFIA) policy manual holders will be issued regarding distribution of paper copy of policy manuals. One paper copy of a release will be provided to each local/district office location. The paper copy is provided as back-up to FIA's online manuals in case technical difficulties make computer access impossible.

Exception: In anticipation of the reduced distribution, policy manual holders that have exceptional circumstances, such as reasonable accommodation that may require paper use, are asked to follow local procedures regarding requests.

FIA's online policy manuals provide advantages over paper manual use, including the option to view previous versions. Enhancements to the FrameViewer software will include navigation improvements such as custom cross-references (text links to other manuals/sections); the ability to move private (sticky) notes into new versions of the manual; and choice to tile (view) two documents horizontally or vertically. To refresh, access instructions are provided here. FIA training is available regarding use of and navigation within the online manual program. Contact a District Manager for help in enrolling in a training session.

To access FIA's policy manuals online:

1. **Select** the "Online Manuals" icon from the desktop or, from the "Start" menu.

Select "FIA Applications" then "Online Manuals" to load FrameViewer and "Online Manual News" will appear*.

**OLM News posts new Bulletin release information and provides instructions for using OLM.*

2. **Select** "Exit to OLM"
3. **Select** "OK" in the "OLM Parameters" dialogue box
4. **Select** the title of the manual group (e.g., "Child and Family Services")

5. **Select** from choice to view the manual (CFF)* or the Bulletins (CFB)

**The complete Table of Contents (TOC) will load for the manual you select. Selecting an item will link you to a detailed TOC for that item.*

6. **Select** from the “Table of Contents” each title and the corresponding item number is linked to the related manual item text

To access policy manuals on internet:

Internet versions of policy Bulletins appear on the last business day before the effective date (e.g., 5/31/01 for 6/1/01). Adobe Acrobat Reader 4.0 is required to view the Internet versions of FIA manuals. To access the FIA manuals:

Type <http://www.mfia.state.mi.us/> in the browser’s search window and press “go” and the MFIA homepage will load.

Select the “Studies, Reports, and Plans and Manuals” link from MFIA home page

Select “FIA Manuals” from the list

Select the policy manual to be viewed from the “Current Policy & Procedures Manuals” list.
