Year	Year that taxpayer(s) filed.
Absent Parent Name	Name as it appears on microfiche.

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Joint Return	A check mark in the box next to "yes" indicates that the absent parent filed a joint return. A check mark in the box next to "no" indicates that the parent filed an individual return.
Name of Spouse	Spouse's name if a joint return was filed.
Address	Street address, city and zip code of absent parent.
Social Security Number	Social security number of the primary tax filer. If a joint return was filed, the primary filer is the name listed first on the tax return.
Batch Code	The first five digits indicated the exact filing date (YMMDD); e.g., 70416 = April 16, 1987. The remaining numbers are reference codes used by the Michigan Department of Treasury.
