

OVERVIEW

The Child Protection Law (CPL), 1975 PA 238, requires the reporting of child abuse and neglect by certain persons, including certain DHS employees, and permits the reporting of child abuse and neglect by all persons.

All eligibility specialists, family independence specialists and family independence managers are required to report suspected child abuse and neglect.
