JR1 122**RETENTION OF JUVENILE JUSTICE PROGRAM DOCUMENTS**

Item revised to reflect use of approved general and agency-specific record retention schedules which were approved in February 2011. Revision expands on contents of skeletal files and adds requirement for annual reviews of record holdings.

JR2 231**SEX OFFENDER REGISTRATION**

Item revised to reflect changes in Michigan sex offender registration law that took effect July 1, 2011. Change in law splits listed offenses into three tiers of increasing severity and reduces the number of offenses which require registration by juveniles. Change in law also modified criteria for juveniles to petition for removal from the sex offender registry.

Reason: Revised sex offender registration law, 1994 PA 295, as amended, MCL 28.721 et seq.

JR3 351**BLOODBORNE PATHOGENS AND UNIVERSAL PRECAUTIONS**

Item revised to clarify the relationship between the OSHA Bloodborne Pathogen standard, training and universal precautions under 29 CFR 1910.1030.
