1) Date of Application

If clients contact a local or district office where they do not reside, do the following:

- Give or send them an application, the address, and phone number of the correct county or district office.
- Inform them the processing time begins when they submit their application with at least the minimum information required to register the application.
- If they choose to complete the application and turn it in at your office, accept it, register it, and electronically send it the same day to the correct county or district office.
- If an application is auto-registered to a county or district office where the client does not reside, electronically send it the same day to the correct county or district office.

Note: The application date is the date it is received by MDHHS.

Reason: Establish when the date of application begins.

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2) Update to DHS-1004, Generation Reasons

The DHS-1004, Health Care Coverage Supplemental Questionnaire, is used to gather additional information when an applicant is not found eligible for any MAGI-related eligibility group or indicates a disability on the DCH-1426.
