**Subject(s)****Food Assistance Program (FAP) Asset Change**

**BAM 105, 117, 809 and BEM 212, 213, 400, 406, 556, 610, and 617**

**FAP Only**

FAP groups that are categorically eligible no longer have an asset requirement. Non-categorically eligible FAP groups will continue to have an asset requirement, however, their asset limits have changed. For non-categorically eligible groups, the asset limit for an SDV group is \$4,250 and for a non SDV group is \$2,750.

The following FAP groups are non-categorically eligible:

- Groups where any member is disqualified for an intentional program violation (IPV).
- Groups where any member is disqualified as a fleeing felon.
- Groups where the head of household has an employment related disqualification.
- Groups that are SDV and their gross income is over the 200 percent categorically eligible income limit, and still eligible for benefits.

*Reason:* Change in state law for FAP assets.
